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- One of the Partnerships under Horizon Europe (Pillar 2 - Global Challenges & European Industrial Competitiveness)
- Total budget of appr. €305 million with an EC Contribution of €91 million (30% of the total budget)

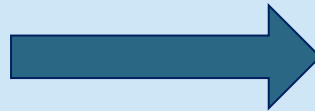

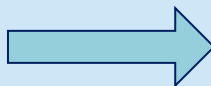

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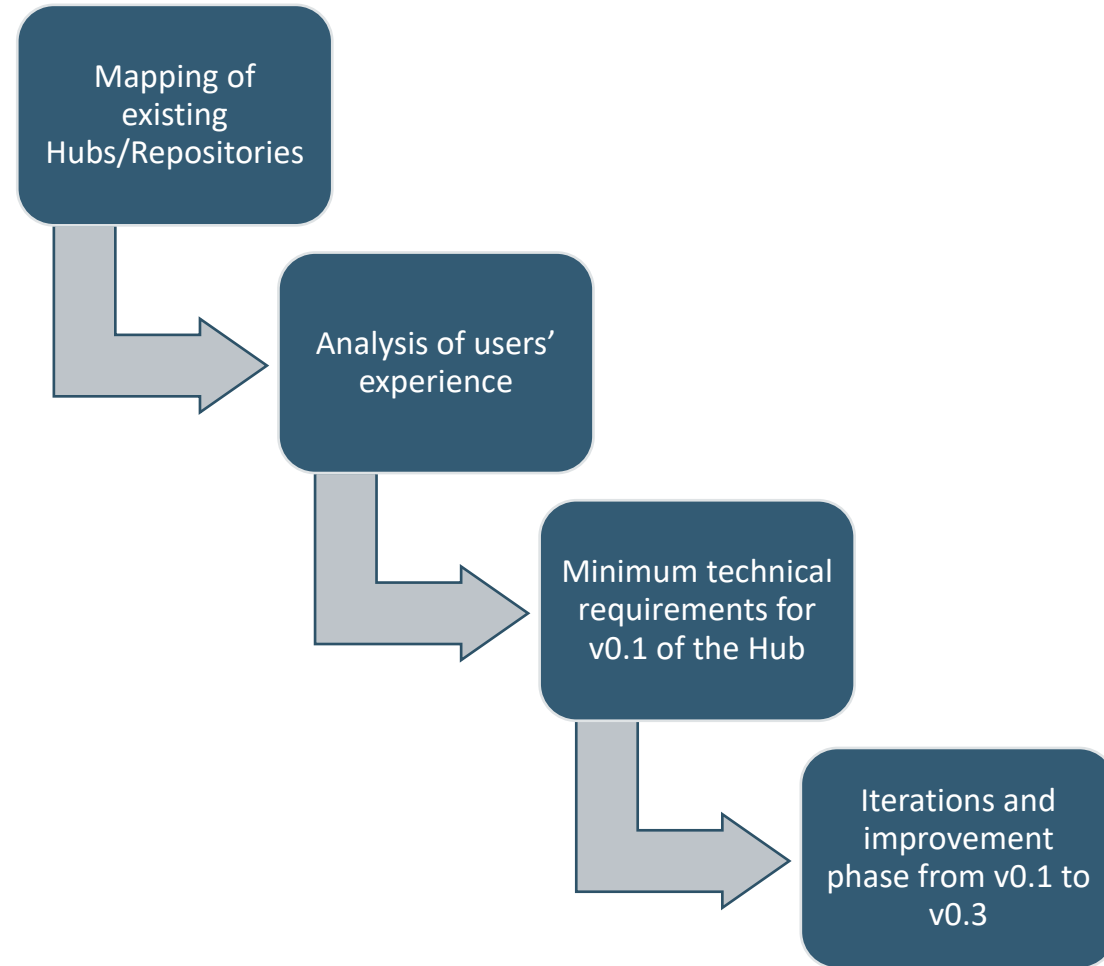
THCS Knowledge Hub: Rationale and Ambition

The aim is to co-design and implement the THCS Knowledge Hub which will act as a multi-functional platform fostering capacity-building support, exchange of good practices, knowledge and experience of different health and social care actors at macro, meso and micro levels for the transformation of health and social care sectors.

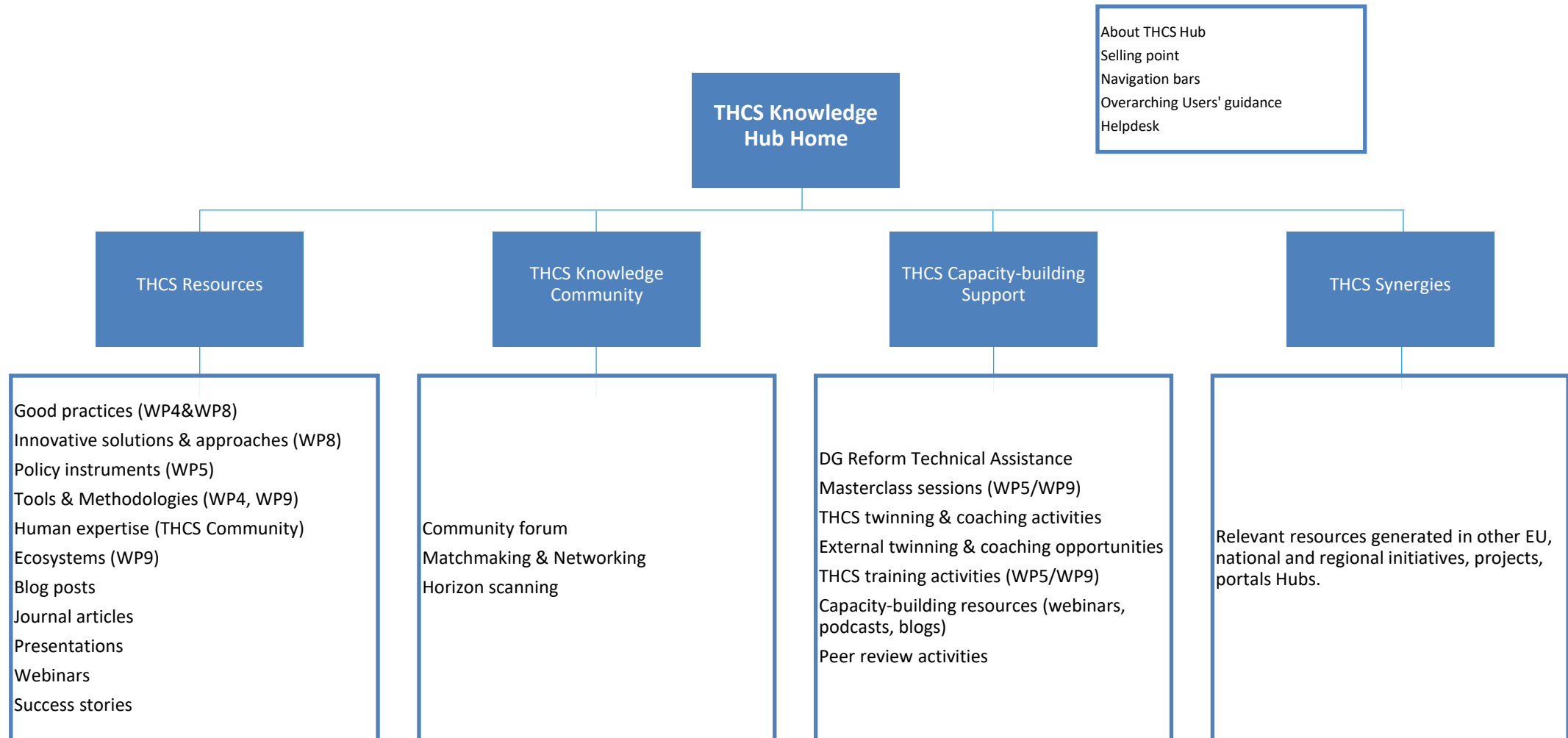
THCS Knowledge Hub: Key designing principles

- The key driving force for the development of the Hub is a **bottom-up approach** with the **users at the centre of co-design process**.
- The Knowledge Hub is **an online platform designed as a module-based platform**.
- **Several iterations of co-design are being undertaken** to enable continual improvement in the development of the Hub.
- **Mapping of existing Hubs and knowledge exchange platforms was conducted** to ensure we build on the existing resources and tools rather than duplicating the efforts and reinventing the wheel.

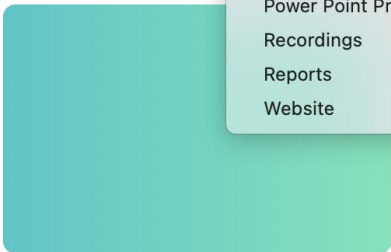

The Joint Action (JA) on implementation of digitally enabled integrated person-centred care (JADECARE) is part of a series of initiatives the EU has launched to face the challenges of the transformation of health and care in the EU. JADECARE intends to reinforce the capacity of health authorities to successfully address important aspects of health system transformation, in particular the transition to digitally enabled, integrated, person-centred care in the EU. For this purpose, 16 EU countries participate in JADECARE. In order to achieve these goals, four **"Early Adopters"** of original Good Practices support **"Next Adopters"**, i.e. participating regions of Member States to transfer the successful practices and generated knowledge into the healthcare systems of the participating partners.
