THCS Knowledge Hub in the context of THCS project







- One of the Partnerships under Horizon Europe (Pillar 2 Global Challenges & European Industrial Competitiveness)
- Total budget of appr. €305 million with an EC Contribution of €91 million (30% of the total budget)





- 64 partners
- 23 Member States and HE Associated Countries
- 9 regions


THCS Knowledge Hub: Key designing principles



- The key driving force for the development of the Hub is a bottom-up approach with the users at the centre of co-design process.
- The Knowledge Hub is an online platform designed as a module-based platform.
- Several iterations of co-design are being undertaken to enable continual improvement in the development of the Hub.
- Mapping of existing Hubs and knowledge exchange platforms was conducted to ensure we build on the existing resources and tools rather than duplicating the efforts and reinventing the wheel.




Methodology for co-design v0.1 of the Hub



INTEGRATED CARE

The Joint Action (JA) on implementation of digitally enabled integrated person-centred care (JADECARE) is part of a series of initiatives the EU has launched to face the challenges of the transformation of health and care in the EU. JADECARE intends to reinforce the capacity of health authorities to successfully address important aspects of health system transformation, in particular the transition to digitally enabled, integrated, person-centred care in the EU. For this purpose, 16 EU countries participate in JADECARE. In order to achieve these goals, four "Early Adopters" of original Good Practices support "Next Adopters", i.e. participating regions of Member States to transfer the successful practices and generated knowledge into the healthcare systems of the participating partners.
